

## Classification of Research Achievements

1. Published books (As a rule, academic books, bilingual dictionaries/dictionaries, translated versions, registered with an ISBN)
  - a. Single author b. Editor c. Co-author or contributor
2. Original articles (Restricted to articles in the following categories. For categories (d) and later, specify whether the paper has been peer reviewed or not.)
  - a. Publications in international academic journals (editors are international)
  - b. Publications in domestic academic journals
  - c. Dissertations for a degree
  - d. University reports, experiment reports, and publications by a chapter of an academic society
  - e. Proceedings adhering to the guidelines of an academic paper, academic conference reports (not including executive summaries for lectures), or research reports adhering to the guidelines of an academic society
3. Review papers
  - a. International magazines and academic journals b. Domestic academic journals c. Bulletins and institutional publications (excluding research abstracts)
4. Academic awards
  - a. Academic awards b. Academic incentive awards c. Other (from corporations, organizations,

chapters of an academic society, study groups, etc.)

5. Patents (pertaining to your expertise and that have been posted in publications)

6. Species registration

7. Survey and experiment reports

8. Government research grants and other external grants

9. Presentation at domestic and international academic conferences (Only within the past five years. If there are many, you may select which to include.)
